### Information about Nammo Lakshmi Yojana 2024-25

The Government of Gujarat, initiated the Nammo Lakshmi Yojana. The Yojana provides financial support to teenage girls for their education. Eligible students in classes 9 and 10 will receive INR 500 per month, while those in classes 11 and 12 will receive INR 750 per month. Funds will be directly transferred to the beneficiaries' bank accounts. Amity School has achieved 100% registration for the scheme.

## Highlights of June 2024

### Enrichment Programme for students of Std XII (5/6/24)

Amity School organised an Enrichment Programme for Std XII students focused on 'Career Prospects for a Global Student' by **Dr Vishal Bhadani, Pro Vice Chancellor Lok Bharti University, Senosara**. ### 1st AISV, AISB and Amity School Teachers' Collaborative Meet (06/6/24)

The collaborative meeting conducted by Amity School and AISV was part of the School Improvement Plan, featuring mapped goals and objectives. The main objective was to discuss student learning needs, share, and provide feedback on instructional practices. The training session was conducted in three stages: the **Foundation Stage**, the **Preparatory Stage**, and the **Middle Stage**, wherein senior teachers from all three schools led the training.



## Teacher's Training Programme (5/6/24-8/6/24)

The new academic session 2024-25 at Amity School, Bharuch, commenced with a dynamic Teacher's Training Programme. On June 5th, **Dr. Vishal Bhadani** highlighted dopamine's role in learning, introduced diverse teaching methods, and emphasized the importance of teacher happiness. He also discussed the impact of AI in education, asserting, "Those who can be replaced, should be replaced," and recommended several educational books.

On June 7th, **Dr. Bhavna Sheth**, a renowned **Obstetrician and Gynaecologist** from Bharuch, presented her book "Antidote To Aging." 
